- * New galleries and exhibitions
- * Innovative exhibits and presentations
- * New outdoor science expositions and outreach science activities
- * Contemporary and significant developments in science and technology
- * History of science and technology with special reference to India
- * Science and Society
- * Visitor's studies in science center/museum
- * New concepts in science communication

The articles and reviews must be accompanied by an abstract of not more than 200 words. We request manuscripts along with photographs and figures to be submitted to the Chief Editor via ncsmin@vsnl.com or ch.ed.propagation@gmail.com. The text file should be saved in **word document (*.doc or *.txt)** and can be sent as an attachment with email message. Please provide mailing addresses (including telephone, fax and e-mail), title and institutional affiliation for each author. The photographs and figures should be saved in ***.jpg or *.tiff** format with high resolution and may also be sent in CD directly to the Chief Editor by post/courier. Bibliographies and references should conform to the style presented in the journal.

Manuscripts submitted to *Propagation* should not be under consideration by any other publishers nor may the manuscripts have been previously published elsewhere. Submitted manuscripts will be considered for publication only after authentic critical review. All rights are reserved.
